Children will be reciting numbers to 100 and counting at least 20 objects accurately. They will be finding half of a shape and of an amount up to 10. Children will be adding on 2 or 3 by counting on using a number track and learning how to partition numbers in different ways. Children will solve practical problems involving pairs which make 10. We will be measuring and comparing the capacities of different containers

### Communication and Language/ Literacy

Our English for this term will focus on stories about families and family life.
