Our Christian Value for this half term is JUSTICE

The value of justice is about the quality of being fair and treating everyone fairly under established rules and laws. Justice is linked to the values of 'Respect, Compassion, Equality and Hope'.

Lady Justice is one of the most famous landmarks in London. It is a bronze statue that stands on the domed roof of the Old Bailey. This building houses the central criminal courts where people who are accused of breaking the law are tried by a judge and jury to find out if they are 'guilty' and should be punished or 'not guilty' and can go free.

Lady Justice was designed to be a symbol of justice. In her left hand the scales of truth and fairness and in her right hand a double edged sword representing the power of reason and justice.



As a school we will be learning about Justice through collective worships and class discussions about :

- Different ways we can show justice at home and in school
- People who fought for justice and fairness
- Countries when justice does not occur and the effect this has on the people who live there
